### TRANSPORT FACILITY

School runs an efficient transport system plying to nearby areas. Each school bus is equipped with GPS and CCTV camera. Decision of school authority regarding routes, timings and pick up points will be finalized in the beginning of session and no changes proposed by parents would be considered during the session. Students are expected to be at the designated bus stop at least five minutes prior to the scheduled time of arrival of the bus.

For availing /discontinuing the bus facility in the middle of the term, an application will have to be submitted to the Principal in advance and permission for the same shall be sanctioned at vehicle stop. A lady attendant accompanies the students in the bus for their proper care. Fee is payable along with the school fee. The buses are also equipped with first aid box.

# **TOURS**(stepping beyond the school gates)

We organise Educational tours for both students and teachers every year. Tours play a vital role in educating students in a practical and interesting manner. Tours provide an opportunity for total immersion in natural environment and social setting.



# **CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS**

- i) Students must be polite and disciplined. They will always remember that the school is judged by the conduct of its students.

- iii) Parents are not allowed to meet the children or teachers during the school hours without the prior permission of the Principal.
- iv) Parents are requested to attend all the PTMs for the academic progress of the child.
- v) Parents co-operation is solicited in maintaining punctuality, regularity and discipline.
- vi) No child will be allowed to leave the school during school hours. In exceptional cases the child is allowed to go with parents only after seeking permission from the Principal.
- vii) For obtaining leave for more than one day, parents are requested to get the leave application sanctioned by the Principal.

# **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

Admission open for children of all sections of the society from the second week of February. Children seeking admission to **Nursery should be 3+yrs.** 

Admission to other classes is subjected to the availability of seats and satisfactory performance in the screening entrance test. The students will be tested on the following subjects:-

1 to V English, Hindi, EVS and Maths.

VI to VII English and Hindi (Grammar & Composition), Maths & Science

IX and XI English and Hindi (Grammar and Composition), Maths, Science and S. Sc.

The documents required for admission:-

- i) Photo copy of Birth Certificate.
- ii) Photo copy of Aadhar Card of student and parents.
- iii) Copy of caste certificate.
- iv) School Leaving certificate of previous school.
- v) Report Card of previous class.
- vi) Three passport size photographs of the student.
- vii) Photocopy of Parivar Pahchan Patra. (PPP)

The Principal reserves the right to refuse admission without assigning any reason. He also reserves the right to issue TC to student on the ground of indisciplined or unfair activities.

# **WITHDRAWALS**

Student can withdraw his/her name by giving an application one month before.

In the absence of such an application, the fee for the ongoing month will be charged.

No transfer certificate will be issued until all the dues are cleared.

If the result is poor consistently for two years, the student can be asked to leave the school.

The school authorities reserve the right to dismiss those students who fail to maintain discipline in the school.

#### RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE PAYMENT OF TUITION FEE

All the dues are to be deposited at school fee counter by the 10th of every month, otherwise the fine will be imposed as follows:-

From 11th to 20th: Rs.50/-

From 21st to end of month: Rs.100/-

Next month onwards: Rs. 200/- per month

Dues deposited once shall not be refunded in any case.

#### Fee Schedule:

Fee is to be deposited every month. But in May and February it is for two months.

- i) For the month of May and June is to be deposited in May.
- ii) For the month of February and March is to be deposited in February.

No student will be allowed to appear in the Annual Examination, if he/she has not cleared the dues.

The fee is to be deposited within time and no reminder will be given for the same. Principal reserves the right to issue TC on the grounds of non-payment of school dues.
