

BALIKA SHIKSHA, KANYA BHARTI & BAL BHARTI



TRANSPORT FACILITY

School runs an efficient transport system plying to nearby areas. Each school bus is equipped with GPS and CCTV camera. Decision of school authority regarding routes, timings and pick up points will be finalized in the beginning of session and no changes proposed by parents would be considered during the session. Students are



expected to be at the designated bus stop at least five minutes prior to the scheduled time of arrival of the bus.

For availing /discontinuing the bus facility in the middle of the term, an application will have to be submitted to the Principal in advance and permission for the same shall be sanctioned. A lady attendant accompanies the students in the bus for their proper care. Fee is payable along with the school fee. The buses are also equipped with first aid box.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- vi) No child will be allowed to leave the school during school hours. In exceptional cases the child is allowed to go with parents only after seeking permission from the Principal.
- vii) For obtaining leave for more than one day, parents are requested to get the leave application sanctioned by the Principal.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

IX and XI English and Hindi (Grammar and Composition), Maths, Science and S. Sc.

The documents required for admission:-

- iii) Copy of caste certificate.
- iv) School Leaving certificate of previous school.
- v) Report Card of previous class.
- vi) Three passport size photographs of the student.
- vii) Photocopy of Parivar Pahchan Patra. (Family ID)

The Principal reserves the right to refuse admission without assigning any reason. He also reserves the right to issue TC to student on the ground of indisciplined or unfair activities.

WITHDRAWALS

Student can withdraw his/her name by giving an application one month before.

In the absence of such an application ,the fee for the ongoing month will be charged.

No transfer certificate will be issued until all the dues are cleared.

If the result is poor consistently for two years, the student can be asked to leave the school.

The school authorities reserve the right to dismiss those students who fail to maintain discipline in the school.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE PAYMENT OF TUITION FEE

All the dues are to be deposited at school fee counter by the 10th of every month, otherwise the fine will be imposed as follows:-
